How we make it happen

In 2014, Dine for Life chose Australian NFP Child Wise, to be the recipient of the funds raised through our dining events. Child Wise work to prevent abuse and exploitation of children throughout Australia.

These funds will enable Child Wise to implement the **Speak Up Program** which was developed to connect with vulnerable children, families and community through a culturally informed and safe program that builds capacity in the awareness and prevention of child abuse within Indigenous communities.

What's the issue?

Child sexual abuse is an issue that knows no boundaries. It occurs in all societies; regardless of race, religion, socio-economic standing, culture and beliefs.

- 40,000 children in Australia will not sleep in their own bed tonight as it is not safe to do so
- Last year over 250,000 reports about abuse and neglect in Australia-that equates to 1 every 2 minutes, less than 50 percent were investigated by Child Protection
- More babies and infants under 12 months were abused than any other age group
- 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 7 boys will be sexually abused in their life
